Course outcome of history

CO8: articulate factual and contextual knowledge of specific places and times to make careful comparison across time space and culture and to how each generation (including their) uses the past for present purpose.

PO9: student should understand academic honesty, a concept presented to them in all history classes.

PO10: student should understand the basic skills that historian use in the research.

PO11: students should understand the basic skills that historian use in writing.

PO12: students should understand the basic tools of historical analysis.

PO13: students should understand the value of diversity.

PO14: students should develop a secular Outlook towards society.

PO15: students should believe in the equality of man irrespective of cast, creed, religion and colour.

PO16: students should learn to believe in the ideas of religious toleration.
